

into the negotiated rate of **\$153/night** (+ tax). This rate is more than competitive with other hotels in San Diego's downtown district in the springtime. (Note that upgraded rooms are available if you're willing to pay a higher daily rate.) *Guest rooms are expected to go fast, so do not delay.*

A high number of early room reservations will help us negotiate better deals with the hotel, which is why we're encouraging you to reserve your room early. Reunion rates are good for three days before



and after the reunion, *if the hotel has rooms available during those periods.*

Important: The day before the reunion, May 6, will be check-in and registration. The day after, May 10, will be checkout, unless you plan to stay longer.

This web address <https://book.passkey.com/go/3SistersReunion2019> opens to the hotel's passkey web link, set up exclusively for Midway Class Veterans to reserve their guest rooms. Select the "Make A Reservation" box and reserve the room and dates you want for your stay. You can cancel your reservation up to 72 hours before the reunion without any charge to your credit card. **To reserve**

your room by phone, dial 619-232-3861, then select "Zero" at the prompt to talk to a guest service agent. Tell the agent you're with the Midway Class Carrier reunion group.



The next steps in putting together this reunion are to negotiate and sign a contract with the USS Midway Museum for the Grand Banquet program and dinner on the flight deck, and to select and develop a master registration form listing reunion activities and costs, **SO THAT WE CAN ALL START SIGNING**

Proposed By-laws Changes for 2018.

Proposed changes are underlined.

Amend Article VII, Sec. 2 Responsibilities of Treasurer as follows:

f) At his discretion set up various funds, such as "Museum", "Ships", **Relief Fund**, etc., with the approval of the Executive Board. Any funds so designated must conform to the requirements of Article II.

Replace Article X with the following:
Article X

DUES:

Sec. 1 The dues of the U.S.S. Coral Sea CVA-43 shall be \$20.00 per year for the period of January 1st to December 31th. Any dues increase must be recommended by the Execu-

tive Board and voted on by the members present at the annual business meeting. Any increase would be retroactive to January 1st. of the year in which the increase is approved. All plank owners i.e. all those on the Ship's original commissioning crew shall pay no membership fee. All those whose birthdate is prior to December 31, 1932 shall pay no dues.

Sec. 2 All former Commanding Officers of USS Coral Sea shall pay no dues.

Sec. 3 Any delinquent members may be reinstated by the payment of current dues.
